

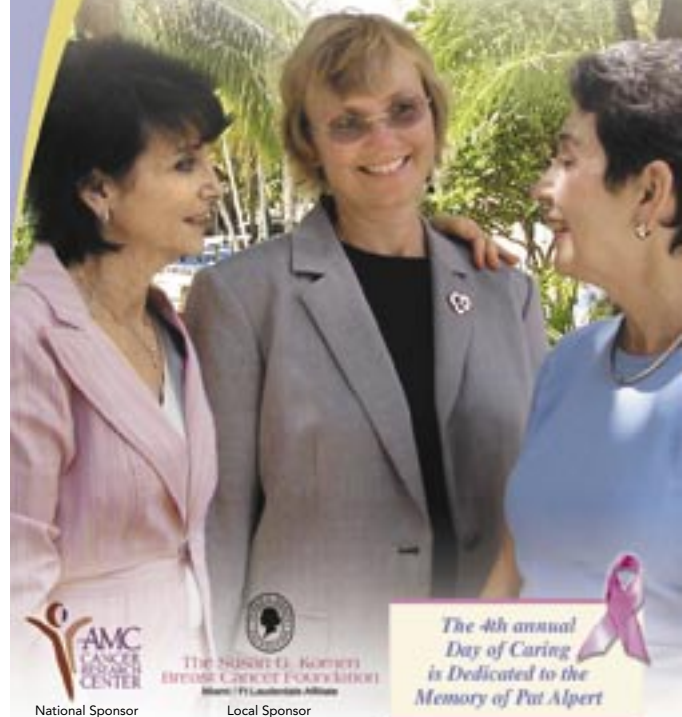

Morning Speaker Barnet Alpert, D.O.



Dr. Barry Alpert has been an osteopathic physician, specializing in family practice, for the past 32 years. He provided loving support throughout his wife Pat's battle with breast cancer, and will share his very personal as well as professional insights into how they, their children and grandchildren, lived with her illness.

A native New Yorker, Dr. Alpert received his Doctor of Osteopathy at the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine and completed his Internship at Interboro General Hospital in Brooklyn, New York.

Following his internship, he served as a Captain in the United States Army and was awarded the Bronze Star for Meritorious Service in Viet Nam.

Since 1990, Dr. Alpert has been a Clinical Assistant Professor, General Practice, at Nova-Southeastern University of the Health Sciences, College of Osteopathic Medicine. Dr. Alpert is a Fellow of the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians and the American College of Utilization Review Physicians.

He is a member of many professional organizations, including the American Osteopathic Association and the Florida Osteopathic Association.

Keynote Speaker Dr. Robert DerHagopian



Dr. Robert P. DerHagopian, or Dr. D., as his many patients know him, has touched the lives of so many women and men in South Florida and beyond. He is accomplished, involved, and dedicated to his life's work — the practice of surgical oncology with specialty in diseases of the breast.

After graduation from Tufts University School of Medicine in 1969, Dr. DerHagopian completed his internship and residency at Boston City Hospital and Tufts New England Medical Center. He was a Fellow in Transplantation at the Veteran's Administration Hospital in Boston and returned to Tufts New England Medical Center, Department of Surgery, as Chief Resident, from 1973 to 1974.

Over the next two years, Dr. DerHagopian served in the United States Navy Medical Corps on Active Duty. He continued his military service as a Commanding Officer with the United States Naval Reserve and retired with the rank of Captain in 1996. Following his active duty service, Dr. DerHagopian came to Miami and completed his Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Surgical Oncology at the University of Miami School of Medicine in 1977.

He is a member of a long list of professional and honorary organizations. Dr. DerHagopian has several prestigious honors and awards to his credit, including the National Defense Medal and Certificate of Achievement as State Chairman for Cancer Programs in the State of Florida for the American College of Surgeons.

Dr. DerHagopian has been extremely involved in the University community, serving on many committees and assuming leadership roles including Medical Director of Jackson Memorial Hospital and University of Miami Hospitals and Clinics as well as Director of Jackson Memorial Hospital's Tumor Clinic.

As a researcher, Dr. DerHagopian has been published in numerous medical journals and has presented his findings at conferences throughout the United States. He has collaborated with many of the most respected oncologists and surgeons in our community and throughout the Southeast region. He was also co-chairman of the 2005 Miami Breast Cancer Conference.
